



1 & 2 THESSALONIANS

BOB NIENSTADT..... **ROOM 14-15**

The two Thessalonians letters are believed to be some of the oldest literature in the New Testament. Paul possibly wrote the letter around 51A.D. dating it before transcripts of the gospels was written. While they are a study in contrasts (many of the concerns of the first letter disappear in the second), the letters challenge the reader to be strong in their faith. This class will be both textual and conceptual, with a great deal of emphasis on the Christian concepts of the study.



A NEWCOMER'S GUIDE TO THE BIBLE

The typical guide to the Bible aims at readers who already know most biblical terms and events. Yet as many as half of our adults do not have a cursory knowledge of the Bible.
