

Good evening, dear brothers and sisters! I am sharing with you joyful news from the life of the Church of Christ in Warsaw.

1. On June 24, Svetlana was baptized. We helped her to settle down in Warsaw. Sveta is from Zaporozhye, she is my wife's friend. My wife talked a lot about Jesus with her, and we prayed that the Lord would touch her heart. Praise the Lord for the saved soul!

2. On June 27, a young girl from Kramatorsk was also baptized, her name is Diana. The Lord brought her to the Church with her mother 10 years ago. Diana's mother, her name is Inna, was baptized a long time ago. Diana came to the Church of Christ as a child, and the Lord took care of her from childhood. Now Diana is 14 years old and she has decided to make a Covenant with God. It was a real holiday for Diana's mother and the whole Church of Christ. Please pray that the Lord will continue to add saved souls to the Church.

3. The Lord touched our hearts, and we helped Anna and her son Artem to move to Warsaw. This woman is not from the church, but she comes to worship with believers. We are familiar with her from Zaporozhye. Anya could rarely come to the meeting of the Church of Christ in Zaporozhye, and then disappeared for a long time. Now she turned to us with a request to help with money and food. Doctors found a lump on the stomach of her eldest son Timur. An examination was scheduled to confirm or refute the diagnosis of a malignant tumor. All the money that Anya had was spent on these examinations. Sveta and her daughter Julia turned to us for help. They are not from the Church, but people from the "world". We met Sveta in Zaporozhye about a year ago. Sveta communicated with us, but did not come to church. When the war began (February 24, 2022), Sveta and her daughter were evacuated from Zaporozhye in early March. Volunteers settled them in a small Polish village for 3 months. Everyone believed that the war in Ukraine would end by this time. But in June she had to move out from the house. Sveta and her daughter had nowhere to go. Sveta stubbornly searched for a job as a nurse with the elderly and with the possibility of living. But, in the small towns of Poland there are no jobs for women! Sveta and her daughter Yulia practically ended up on the street. They moved to a hostel for several nights. In desperation, Sveta asked for help, as she did not see a way out. And returning to Ukraine is still very dangerous. We transported Sveta and her daughter to Warsaw (about 200 km), helped with housing and food, and also gave them money for the first time (they bought travel passes for city transport and hygiene items). Praise the Lord that through such difficulties in life, He brought this family to the church. Sveta and her daughter Julia are very grateful for the help and support. It touched their hearts. Now, with gratitude, they come to worship on Sunday. We have already told you the story of Tatyana and her elderly mother, whose leg was amputated in Warsaw. God has touched the hearts of these women to fellowship with us. We understand that Tatiana and her disabled mother are completely alone in Warsaw, without the help and support of loved ones. We offered our help, and the Lord gave us the opportunity to use a car. We take Tatyana and her mother to different hospitals in the city. You need to have physical strength to lift mom out of bed, put her in a wheelchair, and then put her in a car. But, now Tanya's mother, began to leave the house, which they could not afford before. We also help this family with food. Tatyana began to come to Sunday services. Pray that the seed sown in the hearts of these women will bear the Fruit of Repentance.

During the year in Zaporozhye, I visited prison. When the war has started, all the prisoners were evacuated on the west of Ukraine. They still stay there and bear a punishment for the committed crimes. A lot of men continue to call me. Before the war colonies didn't get enough of food and medicine. And now the situation is even worse. One of the guys, the prisoner, asked me to help him with medicine. His name is Sergey. He attended my Bible lessons when I was there. Now his chronic disease got worse, and there are no medicines he needs in prison at all! We bought him the necessary medicines and sent it to a prison in Ukraine.

All these people sincerely thank God for the help they receive through us. This help is possible thanks to your participation and all those who pray and support us. May God bless you and your families for your generous hearts!
